- The II, IV, & VI semester main practical semester exams ( June – July 2025 ) have started from 30-06-2025.He requested all the faculty members who were appointed as examiners to respective labs to upload the marks immediately on the same day evening after completion of exam.
- The II, IV, & VI semester main theory exams are going to commence from 07-07-2025.He requested the faculty members who have not sent their question paper so far,to send question paper ASAP, within the stipulated time with out further delay so that moderation and other related work can be done without any delay.
- Most of the Chairpersons Board of Studies (Autonomous) have sent the panel of moderators if anyone not sent the list, he requested them to send the list immediately. Also the CBoS ensure that the moderator is not the same person who have set the question paper but should belong to the same specialization. - He informed that recently, it has been noticed during review process that in some of the subjects there is lot of variation between the initial marks scored by the students and after review and in some cases, it is exceeding more than 30 marks.To overcome this erratic valuation and for bringing uniformity and transparency we would like to request immediately after the exam is over, the corresponding examiner whose question paper got selected to send KEY and Scheme of evaluation within two to three days during this time the scanning of scripts will be completed. This KEY and Scheme will be distributed to all the evaluators during on screen valuation and also during review process. Thus ensuring uniformity in evaluation and better justice is done to the students.
- Results process of ME IV Sem (CEEP), BE Minors and Honours is completed and by this weekend we are going to publish the results.


